

Did you know that Christmas and Epiphany were foretold in the Old Testament? Christmas in Isaiah. The advent of Christ was prophesied in the Old Testament beginning with the words to Adam in <u>Genesis 3:15</u>. The blessed promise is repeated throughout the Old Testament, and one of these choice prophets is Isaiah. We begin a series based on four texts from Isaiah entitled "Christmas in Isaiah." The four texts are <u>Isaiah 7:14</u>, the prophecy of the virgin birth of Christ, <u>Isaiah 9:1-7</u>, the promise of the great light for a dark world, <u>Isaiah 11:1-10</u>, the promise of peace on earth, and <u>Isaiah 53:1-6</u>, the picture of the Messiah from the manger to the cross. All these texts are of the promised Savior quoted in the New Testament as the fulfillment of the prophecy of the coming Savior.
